

Mainscreen

When you open the fixed cash register, you will see a list of available items in a grid. Each item is displayed with its name and price.

On the left, you have a search field, and if you use sections, you can select them right next to the search field.



Please note: You cannot create your own items in the demo version.



Sell items

Tap on the item you want to sell. The item is automatically added to your sales list on the right-hand side.

If the item contains a deposit, the deposit counter is automatically increased and the deposit amount is added to the price of the item.

As soon as you add items by tapping on them, they will appear in a list on the right-hand side of the view. The name and total price (including deposit, if applicable) is displayed for each item.

Price calculation

Each item price is automatically totaled so that you always have an overview of the total cost of your current selection.

Deposit settings

The deposit settings are taken from the app settings.



Total

The total of the selected items is displayed directly below the sales list. If there are deposit returns, the corresponding total is displayed with the deposit deducted.

Total without deposit deduction

Shows the total amount of the selected items without deduction.

Total with deposit deduction

If there are deposit deductions (due to returns), the total is displayed with the corresponding deduction.



Complete transaction

New transaction



If you want to complete the sale, click on the "New transaction" button. This completes the sale and saves the transaction in the history.

Internal Use




By pressing the small arrow next to the "New transaction" button, you can change its function to "Internal Use" once. If the transaction is then completed via "Internal Use", the item is recorded as a sale, but without generating any revenue. The transaction is marked accordingly as internal consumption in the history.

To get a quick overview of the items in your last order, use the "Last transaction" button in the top right corner.





Change calculator



The change calculator is an intuitive function that calculates the change based on the amount received and the amount to be paid.

Cashless payments (only in the full version)


When this option is enabled, the available cashless payment methods for completing a transaction are displayed here. Depending on your configuration, this may include PayPal, SumUp, or other providers. You can manage these settings and choose which options to display.

Reset transaction

Do you want to reset the selection and start from the beginning? Tap on the "Revert icon" on the right. This removes all selected items and also resets the deposit counter.



History



Transaction overview

All sales made are clearly displayed in the history. Each transaction includes the transaction number, date/time, items sold with prices, and the total amount (including deposit, if applicable). The person responsible for the transaction (if selected) is indicated in the top right corner.

The indicator at the bottom left shows which payment method was used for this transaction. € for cash payments, ⊞ for PayPal, of for internal use and for cashless payments.



Sales statistics (only in the full version)

At the bottom of the list, there is a button to open the sales statistics. It contains:

- Number of all transactions
- Total sales
- Top 10 items
- Payment methods used
- Daily sales as a diagram

Filter and find data

The blue filter icon allows you to filter the history. In addition, there is a search field that you can use to search the entire history using a full-text search.

Data export (Only in the full version)

Select the blue export icon to export all saved transactions as a CSV file.

Delete data

On the top right-hand side, there is a trash can icon that can be used to delete all transactions. A security prompt will appear.
